**RE: TOWN OF HAMIOTA BY-LAW NO. 3/2009
TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC IN THE TOWN OF HAMIOTA**

At their regular meeting of Council on March 4, 2009 Council did give first reading to By-Law 3/2009 which is a Bylaw to regulate traffic within the Town of Hamiota. Prior to passing the By-law in its current form Council would like to have input from the public. Traffic in the Town is currently regulated by By-Law 10/92 and it's amending By-Laws. They will all be replaced by 3/2009.

Much of the proposed By-Law is in place but there are a number of provisions that Council is considering and they would like it brought to your attention. They are as follows:

1. Maple Avenue shall have parallel parking only on both sides.
2. A truck route system is being implemented and will restrict the flow of large truck traffic (a copy of the map is enclosed)
3. The use of Engine Retarder Braking Systems is prohibited.
4. There will now be a designated area for parking larger trucks in Town.
5. A permit system will be put in place to allow temporary access to restricted areas.
