

21 is 3 x 36" culverts. The Transportation and Government Services is approved to install one 1650 mm culvert in Highway 21.

It was agreed that Perry would consider allowing the Municipality to have a total of three 30" culverts in the road allowance upstream of Highway 21. This will give much greater flows above the existing culverts but not so much that it will cause problems downstream.

Transportation and Government Services has a contract ready to go to tender for their culvert and will do so once approvals are in place. They would like the works completed this year. Perry then discussed the proposed works southeast of the six-mile slough. He now has reviewed the profiles and has determined the work that has to be done. The municipality will have to contact three (3) land owners to see if they would consent the subject works. The scope of work would require a cleanout a natural runway that flows south east and lowering one culvert. The work would be approved to proceed subject to land owner consent and verify all culvert sizes along the way.
