10:00 AM Mr. Lee appeared before Council to discuss the concerns he has had with the Oak River over the years. There is currently a build up in the channel to the east of him and water is continually being held up on his property. He wanted to know what council could do about it.

There is currently an application for a licence to do some remedial work but we were awaiting some survey work to be done before any kind of solution can be determined. Culvert sizing downstream should be looked at. Some felt this was solely the responsibility of the Province of Manitoba and they should be contacted to look after it. Council agreed they would pursue that option.

Council thanked Mr. Lee for his time and indicated they would stay in touch with him.
