

If Council wishes to install cross walks on streets that are Provincial responsibility they should apply to the department and the request would be assessed and a recommendation made.

In order for works to move ahead on the provincial streets there would have to be some testing take place on the existing surfaces and sub base to establish the scope of work that would be required. If the Town wanted to look at improving the underground drainage system it would be their responsibility for costs.

Council thanked Herb and Kevin for their presentation and asked if they would proceed with establishing costs for the improvements and a proposal could be assembled for the Province to consider.
