

7. CAO's Report:

- List of prospective crow hunters for 2006 presented for Council's consideration
- Transportation and Government Services working on costing of Street improvements on Maple, Birch and 4th Street. The final cost has to be sent on for approval. The Town will camera various areas of sewer lines to establish the condition of the system and repairs need to be done.
- Underground drainage has to be upgraded if and when streets are done. Currently there are 12 inch pipes in the ground on Maple and 4th. It was recommended that we go with an 18 inch plastic pipe in the future to deal with any possibility of increased flows.
