- Tenders were received for the reconstruction of Maple Avenue, Birch Avenue and 4 Street, Council considered the following Resolution.

RESOLVED that Council accept the tender in the amount of \$361,892.00 plus applicable taxes from Nelson River Construction Inc. Dated August 16, 2006 for the reconstruction and asphalt paving of Maple Avenue, Birch Avenue and 4<sup>th</sup> Street as identified in the Town of Hamiota a Specifications for said project.

- Insituform has confirmed that the downtown sewer lines can be lined with their product. There are 6 areas that require excavation to make repairs to the line prior to paving of the Streets and they can do their work next year. An outline of the required work and a quote is to be forth coming.
- A quotation for various asphalt repairs has been received but Council directed that the low tender for the street reconstruction make a quote as well prior to any decision being made.
- CAO was directed to gather more information on the options to selling the property on Birch Avenue, Roll #23700.
