5. Delegations: 7:30 PM Conditional Use Application CU-01-07-TH – Hamiota Kids Club

The Hearing was called to order at 7:30 pm by Mayor Oakden. Melanie Collie and Carma Hawkins were present on behalf of the Hamiota Kids Club.

Cliff & Bernice Heaman were present and questioned the notification process that was used. They felt that the Notification for 34 3rd Street SE was incorrect. It was explained that the Mid-West Planning administers the notification process and they would use, according to the Planning Act, the most current assessment information. That would have to be confirmed prior to Council’s consideration on the matter.

Melanie confirmed that their current facilities were overcrowded and they had to expand. They intend to renovate and move part of their program to the former Agriculture Building.

There being no further discussion the Chair adjourned the hearing.

The CAO confirmed that the information used by Mid-West Planning was consistent with the most recent Assessment Rolls.

The following Resolution was then considered.

#4 Rothnie – Mathison

RESOLED THAT Council approve Conditional Use Application No. CU-01-07-TH, Mrs. Melanie Colli applicant on behalf of Hamiota Kids Club to allow for the establishment (and expansion) of a Group Day Care Facility in the CC (Commercial Central Zone) on the property legally described as Lot 18, block 8, Plant T.

Approval shall be without conditions.

- Reported on drainage works. Information was obtained from Transportation and Government Services regarding the installation of a culvert under Highway 21 by the Town. Council then considered the following resolution.

#5 Lee – Robertson

WHEREAS the Town of Hamiota has been experiencing drainage concerns, specifically water being held back, at the northerly portion of Town along Highway 21.

AND WHEREAS the Town of Hamiota understands that it can alleviate much of these problems by installing a 450 mm culvert through Highway 21 at an elevation that would place it 300 mm lower than the existing culvert.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Town of Hamiota request permission from Transportation & Government Services to install by directional boring, one (1) 450 mm culvert through Highway 21 at a location approximately 900 meters south of the Town of Hamiota northern boundary.
