### **PUBLIC NOTICE BOARD OF REVISION**

Notice is hereby given that the 2006 Assessment Rolls for the R.M. of Hamiota has been delivered to the Municipal Office at 221 Elm Street, Hamiota, Manitoba, and is open for public inspection during regular office hours. Persons desiring to complain against the assessment may apply to the Board of Revisions in accordance with Section 42 and 43 of The Municipal Assessment Act.

#### ***APPLICATION FOR REVISION***

- 42(1) A person in whose name property has been assessed, a mortgagee in possession of property under subsection 114(1) of *The Real Property Act*, and occupier of premises who is required under the terms of a lease to pay the taxes on the property, or the assessor may make application for the revision of an assessment roll with respect to
- a) liability to taxation;
  - b) amount of an assessed value;
  - c) classification of property; or
  - d) a refusal by an assessor to amend the assessment roll under subsection 13(2).

#### ***APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS***

- 43(1) An application for revision must
- a) be made in writing;
  - b) set out the roll number and legal description of the assessable property for which a revision is sought;
  - c) state the grounds on which the application is based; and
  - d) be filed by
    - i) delivering it or causing it to be delivered to the Hamiota Municipal office at the address below;
    - ii) serving it upon the Chief Administrative Officer, at least 15 days before the scheduled sitting date of the board as indicated in the public notice.

Council will sit as a Board of Revision for the revision of the General Assessment Roll, to hear and determine any complaint that has been duly laid, at the Municipal Office at Hamiota, Manitoba on **Wednesday, November 9, 2005 AT 10:00 A.M.**

The final date on which applications must be received by the Secretary of the Board is Monday, October 24, 2005 at 4:30 p.m.
