

Good Year For RHA

The Assiniboine Regional Health Authority is in good financial shape.

Vice-chair Stafford Shewchuk says administrators are projecting a 2 million dollar surplus by the year end, March 31st.

He notes while finances look good, recruitment is another story, where there's a constant problem of staff shortages.

Shewchuk credits the executive staff for their recruiting efforts, noting it's a difficult job.

The RHA is working on capital projects in Neepawa and Rivers.

Shewchuk says for the 2009, the next health facility scheduled for an upgrade or replacement is the Hamiota Health Centre.
